

The Beekeepers Rap Activity

This is a rhyming couplet. First you and your group have to create your own. The topic is of course..... Bees.

Example: Bees are buzzing around outside. If you see them-no need to hide.

You need to make two rhyming couplets which make it four lines long and you can't use the one you just read.

Then you need to use some of the beekeepers tools that are provided for you to make this poem into a rap. Use the tools for sound effects along with performing **The Beekeepers Rap.**



The Water Relay Activity

The point of this activity is for students to realize how much work it takes for a bee to gather enough nectar to make honey. You need 2 teaspoons or eyedroppers, something to indicate a starting line and four containers. Play Rimski-Korsakov's Flight of the Bumblebee as they race.

- 1. Put your group into two even numbered teams. If the teams do not have the same numbers then choose one person to play twice.
- 2. Give a name to your teams. Line up behind the starting line.
- 3. Using one teaspoon or eye dropper for each team, transfer one cup of water from one container to another one some distance away.
- 4. Maybe the winning team could get a honey of a prize.
